BEFORE INSTALLING or OPERATING JACK

⚠ CAUTION

- ◆ Before using this product, read and fully understand the operating instructions and all decals on the product. This is necessary to prevent injury to the operator and damage to the product.
- ◆ Roll jack forward before moving vehicle on or off lift.
- ◆ Do not attempt to use this jack for anything other than its intended purpose.
- ◆ If jack begins to tilt as the vehicle is raised, STOP! Lower jack and reposition the vehicle.
- ◆ Do not use this jack if it is visibly worn, distorted or damaged.
- ◆ Always wear appropriate eye protection.

⚠ WARNING

- ◆ Maximum lift capacity of this jack is 4500 lbs (2041 kg)
Exceeding this could result in severe personal injury or death.
- ◆ Lift vehicle at manufacturer's recommended pick-up points only.
Vehicle weight must be evenly distributed on each jack lift pad.
- ◆ Keep fingers and hands clear of all pinch points at all times.

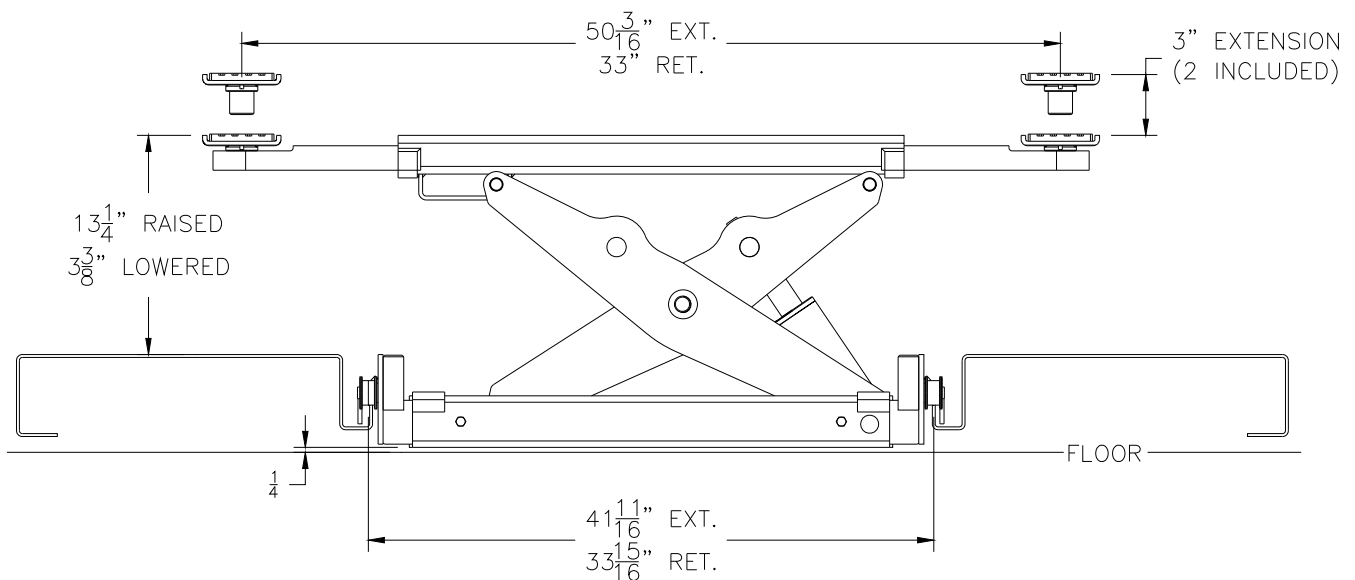

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INSTALLATION

- 1) Place jack assembly on lift rack rails.
- 2) Once side members are adjusted and jack is centered between the rails, tighten the (4) hex bolts (2 per side) to lock in place, Fig 2.

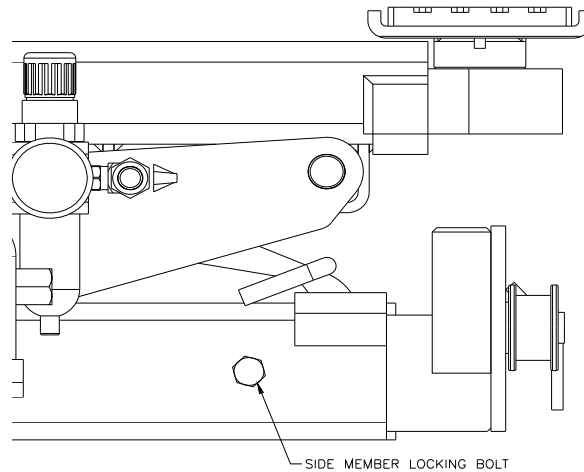

Operation

Note: Before lifting a vehicle, operate the jack through a couple of cycles to become familiar with the controls.

- 1) Roll jack forward before moving vehicle on lift rack. Be sure vehicle is centered on rack, apply parking brake and chock wheels.
- 2) Roll jack(s) to the vehicle manufacturer's recommended pick-up points. Extend lift pad arms to proper lift points. Use lift pad spacers if necessary.
- 3) Raise jack by pumping the jack handle.
- 4) Raise vehicle to desired height.
- 5) Lower jack onto lock.
- 6) To lower jack completely, raise off of lock and turn the valve handle counter clockwise. Push lift pad arms in, remove lift pad spacers (if used). Roll jack forward before moving vehicle off rack.

Loss of power

If for any reason the lift will not raise off the locks or the locks will not retract, consult factory authorized personnel.

DO NOT OVERRIDE ANY SAFETY FEATURE IN AN ATTEMPT TO LOWER THE LIFT.

Maintenance

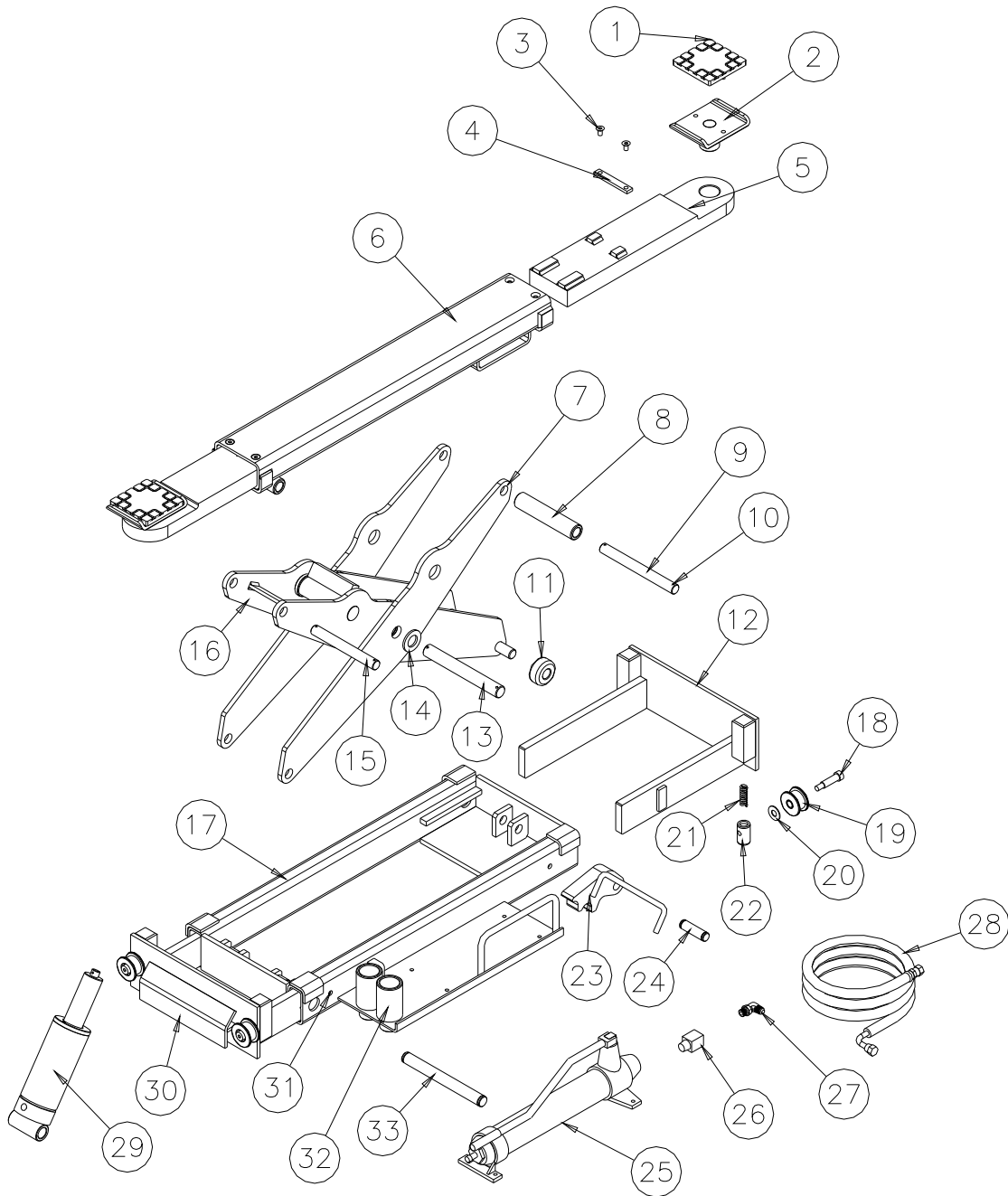
Daily: Inspect jack and its components for damage or excessive wear. Replace parts as required. See parts list. Inspect hydraulic system for leaks.

Annually: Check hydraulic pump oil level if jack is not achieving full rise height. When jack is completely lowered, remove pump from base, hold pump vertical then remove breather plug (knurled screw on pump end) and check oil level. Oil should be at top of filler plug hole. Recommended Oil: AW32- 10wt hydraulic oil, non-foaming, anti rust.

IMPORTANT!

Failure to keep lift free of corrosive agents and solvents will lead to reduced service life, which could result in property damage and/or personal injury. If any problems are encountered, contact your local service representative.
